UK HealthCare Nursing Tuition Contract - work back commitment

- For UK LPNs and RNs, since UK **doesn't offer** an LPN to ADN Bridge, the MSN in Nursing Education or the MSN-MBA programs, after you are accepted, you can apply for the UK Nursing Tuition Contract. A UK Committee will review the applications monthly and let the employee know.

General Admissions Process

- Visit our website at midway.edu or schedule a visit or phone call at midway.edu/experience
 - Completed Midway University Application (submit online at apply.midway.edu)
 - Submit official transcripts and test scores
 - GPA of 2.5 (4.0 scale)
 - ACT 18 Composite
 - 2.0 Cumulative Transfer GPA
 - Admissions requirements for the Nursing program are separate.
 - Complete the FAFSA.
 - You will be notified by email when your financial aid package is available
 - Complete the nursing application
- *College and final high school transcripts must be sent officially meaning via mail directly from the issuing institution, secure third party sender (like the National Student Clearinghouse or Parchment) or can be hand delivered in a sealed envelope directly from the issuing institution.

Multiple Pathway Options

- Associate Degree in Nursing (Traditional, Evening, Online/Hybrid options)
- Master of Science in Nursing (Education, MSN/MBA Dual Degree options)

Note: While we have other nursing programs available, the UK Tuition Assistance Program will only pay for programs not offered at UK which are the above listed programs.

Associate Degree in Nursing (Traditional, Evening, Online/Hybrid)

Program Highlights/Timeline/Application Process:

- High first-time pass rate with multiple cohorts above 90%. Current programmatic accreditation and a long history of a reputable program with 100% job placement. High admission rates for those who meet the programmatic requirements.
- Complete pre-requisite courses: English 101, English 102, College Algebra and Anatomy and Physiology 1 and Lab. Acquire a CNA or equivalent certification, acquire a 21 ACT or TEAS score of 60 and have a minimum 2.8 cumulative GPA on all college courses taken prior to program entry.
- General admission must be acquired first. Nursing application available in February. Cohorts begin in August unless you are an LPN.
- The LPN-ADN bridge option allows students to begin in January as well. Their LPN waives the Fall course that non-LPN students are required to take, hence their Fall start date limitation.

Master of Science in Nursing (Education Option, MSN/MBA Dual Degree)

Program Highlights/Timeline/Application Process:

- General and programmatic admission occur concurrently. Follow general admission process, but also provide RN license, transcript, and resume.
- BSN to MSN (Education) -- 36 credit hours
- ADN to MSN (Education) -- 58 credit hours
- MSN/MBA Dual Degree -- 60 credit hours
- Part-time and full-time options available with small cohorts.
- Multiple entry points

Note. Only the education and MSN/MBA Dual Degree options are available for UK Healthcare tuition reimbursement.

Frequently Asked Questions

- **Are there options for completing practicum hours on the weekends for the MSN programs?**
 - You will have a preceptor at your workplace. Practicum hours are determined between preceptors and students. Because of these relationships there are often opportunities to complete those on the weekends.
- **What days and times do you usually have evening classes for the ADN?**
 - Evening classes typically occur from 6:00-9:00 on Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday.
- **What is the success rate for graduation in the MSN program?**
 - We are currently at a 100% success rate for the MSN/MBA program. The MSN Education track has had a 95% success rate historically.
- **When is the deadline for the ADN program?**
 - The deadline is typically August 1 each year. Students should confirm with the nursing department to make sure that date has not changed for future years since the publication of this presentation.
- **Does Midway have a student help office for those that need extra test taking strategies and/or time?**
 - We have a student success center which offers services such as this for free. We also have an accommodations representative.
- **Is there test prep for the TEAS exam?**
 - Visit atitesting.com to register for the TEAS exam and to find test prep materials and other information.
